PAIN, BRAIN, BODY & SCIENCE: THE EVOLUTION AND PRACTICE OF BRAIN RE-TRAINING TREATMENTS

Speaker: Lorimer Moseley, PhD

Professor of Clinical Neurosciences & Chair in Physiotherapy

The Sansom Institute for Health Research, University of South Australia

Senior Research Fellow, Neuroscience Research Australia, Sydney, Australia

Description: Dr. Moseley will discuss the evolution of pain management from the concept of the neuromatrix through the biopsychosocial concept of modern pain management. In particular, he will discuss the development and implementation of brain re-training treatment strategies such as graded motor imagery. He will also discuss how these concepts can be incorporated into clinicians' practices.

Objectives: At the end of this activity the participant should be able to:

1. Understand the paradigms of the neuromatrix and pain mechanisms.
2. Understand the basic sciences underpinning the use of GMI.
3. Understand how to adapt a GMI program to various patient groups.

Presenter: Dr. Moseley is an internationally acclaimed researcher who completed his doctorate in medicine at the University of Sydney and post-doctorates at the University of Queensland and the University of Sydney. In 2004, he was the first allied health professional to be appointed Nuffield Medical Research Fellow at Oxford University, UK. He has over 75 scholarly works including articles in the British Medical Journal, Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences USA, Brain, PAIN and Neurology. He is Associate Editor of PAIN, the British Journal of Sports Medicine, and Reviews in Pain. In 2007, he received the Ulf Lindblom Award, given by the International Association for the Study of Pain to the outstanding mid-career clinical scientist working in a pain-related field.
